8 Victoria – Chapter 35

An Act to continue an Act, intituled *An Act to regulate the Assize of Bread in the Towns of Saint Andrews and Saint Stephen, in the County of Charlotte*, and to repeal the Acts now in force relating to the Town of Saint Andrews. Passed 27th March 1845.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the third year of the Reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled *An Act to regulate the Assize of Bread in the Towns of Saint Andrews and Saint Stephen, in the County of Charlotte,* and to repeal the Acts now in force relating to the Town of Saint Andrews, be and the same is hereby declared to be in full force until the first day of May which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty.
