8 Victoria – Chapter 3

**An Act to provide for the expenses incurred by the Commissioners of the Provincial Penitentiary. Passed 27th March 1845.**

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That it shall and may be lawful for His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor or Administrator of the Government for the time being, by and with the advice and consent of Her Majesty's Executive Council, to issue a Warrant on the Treasury for the sum of three hundred pounds in favor of the Commissioners of the Provincial Penitentiary, to defray the expenses incurred or which may be incurred by them for the support and maintenance of the inmates of that Establishment.
