8 Victoria – Chapter 66

An Act to annex the Madam Kiswick Island to the Parish of Douglas, in the County of York. Passed 27th March 1845.

Whereas from the situation and local position of the Island situate in the River Saint John, in the County of York, called and known as the Madam Kiswick [Keswick] Island, it is expedient to annex the same to the Parish of Douglas, in said County;

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the said Island be and the same is hereby annexed to and shall hereafter form a part of the Parish of Douglas, in the said County of York, any law or ordinance to the contrary notwithstanding.
