8 Victoria – Chapter 68

An Act to establish the Road leading from Bathurst, in the County of Gloucester, to the Southern termination of the Great Bathurst Road, via Pokemouche, as one of the Great Roads of this Province. Passed 27th March 1845.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the Road leading from Bathurst, in the County of Gloucester, to the Southern termination of the Great Bathurst Road, and running through the Settlements in the Parish of New Bandon, thence through Grand Aunce [Grand Anse] to Waterloo Corner, thence across the Northwest Branch of Caraquet River by End's Bridge, (so called), thence across the Southwest Branch of Caraquet River, thence through the Settlement of Caraquet, thence by the lower or Blackhall Portage to Pokemouche, thence to Tracady, thence to the said Southern termination of the aforesaid Great Bathurst Road, be and the same is hereby established and appointed one of the Great Roads in this Province.
