## An Act to establish Polling Places in the County of Albert. Passed 11th April 1846.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That from and after the passing of this Act, the Polling Places for the Election of Representatives to serve in General Assembly for the said County of Albert, shall be as follows, that is to say:

In the Parish of Hopewell, at or near the site of the new Court House; In the Parish of Coverdale, at or near the house of Lazarus Colpits; In the Parish of Hillsborough, at or near the house of John Beatty; In the Parish of Harvey, at or near the house of John Read, of Germantown.
