9 Victoria – Chapter 31

An Act to authorize the Justices of the Peace for the County of Saint John to make further provision for the payment of the Treasurer of that County. Passed 11th April 1846.

Whereas by the Laws now in force, the Sessions of the respective Counties in this Province are precluded from allowing to the County Treasurers respectively, for their services, per annum, any sum exceeding fifteen pounds, which in the County of Saint John has been found a very inadequate compensation for the services, and responsibility of that Officer;

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the Justices of the Peace for the said County, or the major part of them, at any General Sessions to be holden in and for the said County, are hereby fully authorized and empowered to make such additional compensation to the said Treasurer of that County as they in their discretion may deem right and proper, not exceeding the sum of thirty five pounds per annum, to be paid out of the Contingent Fund of the said County.
