10 Victoria – Chapter 71 (1846)

An Act to increase the Representation of the County of Albert. Passed 7th March 1846.

Whereas it is deemed necessary to increase the Representation of the County of Albert;

I. Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the County of Albert shall be entitled to send one additional Member to serve in the General Assembly of this Province, to be elected by the Freeholders in the said County, in like manner and subject to the like laws, rules and regulations under which Members are elected in the several Counties within this Province.

II. And be it enacted, That this Act shall not be of any force or effect until Her Majesty's assent thereto shall have been duly signified.

[This Act was specially confirmed, ratified and finally enacted by an Order of Her Majesty in Council, dated the 6th day of July, 1846, and published and declared in the Province the 12th day of August, 1846.]
