10 Victoria – Chapter 13

An Act to establish the Road leading from (Shediac to the Nova Scotia Line, via Shemogue, Bay de Verte [Baie Verte] and Jolicure,) as one of the Great Roads of this Province. Passed 12th March 1847.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the Road leading from the Great Post Road at Cole's Island, thence passing through Cole's Island along the present Road to the old Post Road, thence along the same to Hewson's, thence through Jolicure to Bay de Verte [Baie Verte], and thence by the Road through the Emigrant Settlement to Cape Tormentine, be and the same is hereby declared to be one of the Great Roads of this Province.
