10 Victoria – Chapter 37

An Act to authorize her Majesty's Justices of the Peace of the county of Albert to make provision for the payment of County Contingencies. Passed 23rd March 1847.

Whereas the Local Revenues of the county of Albert have been found insufficient to meet the annual expediture of the County Contingencies.

I. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That it shall and may be lawful for Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace thereafter holden, annually to make and order an assessment on the inhabitants of the said County, for such a sum as hey in their discretion shall see fit, not exceeding the sum of one hundred pounds in any one year, for the purpose of providing for the annual Contingent Expenses of the said County; such sum to be assessed, levied, collected and paid agreeably to any Acts now or hereafter to be in force for the assessing, collecting and levying of County rates.

II. And be it enacted, That this Act shall continue and be in force until the first day of May which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty.
