10 Victoria – Chapter 3

An Act to prevent the free Navigation of the Internal Waters of the Province from being impeded by any Railway Works. Passed 12th March 1847.

Whereas it is expedient that the Executive Government of the said Province should have a general control over all Works undertaken by Railway Companies, which might have a tendency to impede the free Navigation of the Internal Waters of the said Province;

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That it shall not be lawful for any Railway Company in this Province to constructor maintain any Tunnels, Bridges, Passages or other Works over or under any navigable River and Canals in the said Province, which may have a tendency to impede the free Navigation of the same.
