10 Victoria – Chapter 57

An act to alter and amend an Act, intituled *An Act to provide for the erection of an Alms House and Work House, and to establish a Public Infirmary in and for the City and County of Saint John.* Passed 14th April 1847.

Whereas in and by the sixth section of an Act made and passed in the first year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act to provide for the erection of an Alms House and Work House, and to establish a Public Infirmary in and for the City and County of Saint John,* it is enacted, inter alia, that the Alms House in the said City shall be used as and for a Public Infirmary, under the care, management and direction of the said Commissioners, (meaning the Commissioners to be appointed under and by virtue of the second section of the said Act:) And whereas, at the time of making such enactment, the said Aim's House, together with the grounds and lands on which it was built, was vested in, and was owned by the Corporation of the said City, and was transferred, with the other property belonging to the said Corporation, in September one thousand eight hundred and forty two, to Trustees, for the benefit of the creditors of the said Corporation, as by reference to the Trust Deed then executed, will more fully and at large appear: And whereas such investment of the Alms House, by the said sixth section, was not warranted;

I. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That so much of the said sixth section of the hereinbefore recited Act, vesting the care, management and direction of the said Alms House, in the Commissioners appointed or to be appointed under and by authority of the second section of the said Act, be and the same is hereby repealed.
