11 Victoria – Chapter 39

An Act to authorize the Justices of the Peace for King's County to levy an assessment to pay off the County Debts. Passed 30th March 1848.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the Justices of the Peace for King's County, at any General Sessions of the Peace to be hereafter holden, or at any Special Sessions to be for that purpose convened, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to make such rate and assessment of any sum not exceeding two hundred pounds, as they in their discretion may think necessary, for paying off the debts due from the said County; the same to be assessed, levied and paid agreeably to and under and by virtue of any Act or Acts which are now or hereafter may be in force in this Province for assessing, levying and collecting the Rates for public charges.
