11 Victoria – Chapter 40

An Act to authorize the Justices of the Peace for the County of Sunbury to levy assessments to defray the County and Contingent expenses thereof. Passed 30th March 1848.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the Justices of the Peace for the County of Sunbury, at any General Sessions of the Peace hereafter to be holden, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to make such rate and assessment of any sum not exceeding one hundred pounds, in such sums and at such times as they in their discretion may think necessary, to defray the contingent and other expenses of the said County; the same to be levied, assessed, collected and paid under and by virtue of any Act or Acts of the General Assembly of this Province in force for assessing and collecting of County Rates.
