11 Victoria – Chapter 44

An Act to authorize the Rector, Church Wardens and Vestry of Saint Mary's Church, in the Parish of Richibucto, to sell certain Lands granted to the said Corporation, and vest the proceeds in other Lands. Passed 30th March 1848.

Whereas the Rector, Church Wardens and Vestry of Saint Mary's Church, in the Parish of Richibucto, are seized and possessed of certain Lands in the Parish of Richibucto, under and by virtue of a Grant from the Crown bearing the date the twenty sixth day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight: And whereas a portion of the said Lands, prior to the issuing of the Grant, had been improved by George Kinread, who is now in the occupation thereof; and the said George Kinread hath agreed to purchase from the said Rector, Church Wardens and Vestry, one hundred acres of the said Land, to include the improvements made by him, at and for a certain sum of money; and the said Rector, Church Wardens and Vestry are desirous of disposing of the same to the said George Kinread, and vesting the proceeds arising from such sale in other Lands for the said Corporation;

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the said Record, Church Wardens and Vestry of Saint Mary's Church, in the Parish of Richibucto, by and with the approbation of the Lord Bishop of the Diocese, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to sell and dispose of one hundred acres of Land to the said George Kinread, his heirs and assigns, in fee simple, for such sum or price as they may agree, and to vest the sum so received in other Lands for the purpose of a Glebe for the Record of the said Church.
