11 Victoria – Chapter 46

An Act to amend an Act, intituled *An Act to authorize the granting of a Tract of Land as a Mill Reserve to the Honorable John Robertson*. Passed 30th March 1848.

Whereas the Mill Reserve mentioned in an Act made and passed in the tenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act to authorize the granting of a Tract of Land as a Mill Reserve to the Honorable John Robertson*, was originally granted on a certain condition, not mentioned in the said recited Act, but attached to the said Mill Reserve, as well as to all other Mill Reserves granted in this Province, and the same was omitted to be inserted in the said recited Act; Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That nothing in the said recited Act made and passed in the tenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act to authorize the granting of a Tract of Land as a Mill Reserve to the Honorable John Robertson*, shall extend or be construed to extend to prevent the Government from selling or disposing of such Mill Reserve, or any part or portions thereof, for actual settlement, in like manner as if such Reserve had not been made, or authorized to be granted, as in the said recited Act mentioned, and in like manner as in the case of all other Mill Reserves in this Province, any thing in this Act, or the said recited Act to which this is an amendment, to the contrary notwithstanding.
