11 Victoria – Chapter 51

An Act to continue and amend the Act to incorporate the Arestook [Aroostook] Boom Company. Passed 30th March 1848.

Whereas an Act made and passed in the seventh year of the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled *An Act to incorporate the Arestook Boom Company*, and another Act, intituled *An Act to continue and amend the Act to incorporate the Arestook Boom Company*, require to be amended.

I. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That from and after the passing of this Act, notwithstanding any thing contained in either of the said recited Acts, the said Corporation shall and they are hereby required to keep the Boom erected by the said Company open during each and every year, from and after the first day of October in each and every year, from and after the first day of October in each and every year, under the penalty of one hundred pounds for each and every day the said Boom shall be kept closed after the said first day of October in each and every year.

II. And be it enacted, That the said Act made and passed in the seventh year of the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled *An Act to incorporate the Arestook Boom Company*, and also the said other Act made and passed in the eighth year of the Reign of Her said present Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled *An Act to continue and amend the Act to incorporate the Arestook Boom Company*, be and the same are hereby severally continued until the first day of August which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty five.
