12 Victoria – Chapter 10

An Act in addition to an Act to regulate the ungranted Ferries in this Province. Passed 8th March 1849.

Whereas great inconvenience and imposition are occasioned to travellers in Steam Boats by unreasonable exactions for landing and embarking Passengers in certain localities in Queen's County; for remedy whereof,

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the provisions of an Act made and passed in the fifth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled *An Act to regulate the ungranted Ferries in this Province*, be and the same is hereby made and construed to extend, so far as the same relates to Queen's County, to the establishments of Ferries from any Public Landing in the said County to Steam Boats passing the same, when the same may be deemed necessary by the Justices of the Peace for the said County in General or Special Sessions assembled, and subject to such rules and regulations as such Justices may from time to time make and ordain.
