12 Victoria – Chapter 23

An Act to repeal an Act, intituled An Act further to facilitate the means of supplying the City of Saint John with Water, and for the more effectual prevention and extinguishment of Fires within the said City. Passed 27th March 1849.

Be it enacted by the, Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the ninth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled *An Act further to facilitate the means of supplying the City of Saint John with Water, and for the more effectual prevention and extinguishment of Fires within the said City,* be and the same is hereby repealed; provided always, that the repealing of the said Act shall not affect or be construed to affect, limit, abridge, or in any manner destroy the remedy or rights of any person or persons, or Body Corporate, against the said Company, in anyway arising under or growing out of said Act, or for or by reason of any matter or thing done, or required to be done, or omitted to be done, under the said Act, but that the rights of every nature and description of all and every person or persons against the said Company shall be and remain as if the said Act had not been repealed.
