12 Victoria – Chapter 25

An Act relating to Buoys and Beacons in the Harbour of Buctouche [Bouctouche], in the County of Kent. Passed 27th March 1849.

Whereas the sum of one half penny per ton is insufficient to keep in repair the Buoys and Beacons of the Buctouche Harbour, in the County of Kent;

- I. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the said Duty be and the same is hereby increased to one penny per ton upon all Vessels entering the Harbour of Buctouche, to be collected and levied agreeably to the direction of the Act of the General Assembly, intituled An Act to repeal an Act, intituled "An Act for the better security of the Navigation of certain Harbours in the County of Northumberland" and to make more effectual provision for the security of the Harbours in the Counties of Northumberland, Kent and Gloucester.
- II. And be it enacted, That this Act shall continue and be in force so long as the said recited Act, and no longer.
