12 Victoria – Chapter 38

An Act for the re-appropriation of the Sums granted to the Counties of Northumberland and Restigouche at the last Session of the Legislature for the purchase of Seed. Passed 14th April 1849.

Whereas under the Act made and passed at the last Session of the last Legislature, intituled *An act to provide for the necessities occasioned by the failure of the Potato and other Crops during the past year*, the sums appropriated to the Counties of Northumberland and Restigouche were not drawn from the Treasury, and the same are now required in those Counties to relieve the present distress, and to procure Seed;

- I. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That it shall and may be lawful for the Justices of the Peace for the Counties of Northumberland and Restigouche, at any General or Special Sessions of the Peace to be called and held as is provided in and by an Act made and passed in the eleventh year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act to provide for the necessities occasioned by the failure of the Potato and other Crops during the past year*, to apply for and receive the amounts required and appropriated to those Counties, and to apply the same as is provided in and by the said Act; provided always, that the amount so to be drawn from the Treasury by the County of Northumberland, shall not exceed the sum of four hundred.
- II. And be it enacted, That the time at which the said sums shall be refunded, shall be two years after the passing of this Act.
