13 Victoria – Chapter 17 Private or Personal Acts

An Act to incorporate the Agricultural Society of Sunbury. Passed 26th April 1850.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly. That there shall be established and located in the County of Sunbury an Association, by the name of "The Agricultural Society of Sunbury," for the purpose of encouraging Agriculture, and that George Hayward, Thomas O. Miles, Honorable Charles Harrison, Calvin L. Hatheway, William Burpe, Thomas Harrison, Isaac Burpe, Nathaniel Hubbard, John Hazen, Charles H. Clowes, John L. Wilmot, John Glazier, George II. N. Harding, Thomas Hartt, Charles Hazen, and William E. Perley, and such other persons as are or may become members of the said Society, shall be and they are hereby constituted a Body Corporate, by the name aforesaid, with all the general powers and privileges incident to Corporations by Act of Assembly in this Province.
