13 Victoria – Chapter 29

An Act to limit the operations of an Act, intituled *An Act for the adjustment of claims of certain purchasers of Crown Lands*. Passed 26th April 1850.

Whereas it is deemed advisable that a time should be appointed within which all claims should be preferred under the provisions of an Act made and passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled *An Act for the adjustment of claims of certain purchasers of Crown Lands;* Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That all applications for relief under the provisions of the said recited Act, shall be made on or before the first day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty one.
