14 Victoria – Chapter 3 New Brunswick Local Acts

An Act to continue an Act to empower the owners of certain Saw Mills on Hammond River, in King's County, to erect and keep up a Boom or Booms for the securing of Saw Logs on the said River. Passed 15th March 1851.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the ninth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act to empower the owners of certain Saw Mills on Hammond River, in King's County, to erect and keep up a Boom or Booms for the securing of Saw Logs on the said River,* be and the satire is hereby continued and declared to be in force until the first day of May which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty six.
