14 Victoria – Chapter 5 New Brunswick Local Acts

An Act to authorize And empower the Justices of the Peace for the County of York to sell the old Gaol Lot in the City of Fredericton. Passed 15th March 1851.

Whereas the Justices of the Peace for the County of York have erected a new Gaol in the said County on a lot of land purchased for that purpose, and in consequence thereof the old Gaol Lot is no longer required for a Gaol or any other County purpose; and it is deemed advisable that the Justices of the General Sessions of the Peace for the said County should be authorized to sell the said old Gaol Lot, and appropriate the proceeds of the sale thereof to the payment of the balance due on the new Gaol and other County debts

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the Justices of the General Sessions of the Peace for the County of York shall and they are hereby authorized and empowered to sell the old Gaol Lot in the City of Fredericton, and appropriate the proceeds thereof to the payment of the balance due on the new Gaol, and for other County debts.
