14 Victoria – Chapter 8

An Act to alter and amend an Act, intituled *An Act to incorporate the New Brunswick Society for the encouragement of Agriculture, Home Manufactures and Commerce throughout the Province*, and to regulate and provide for the same. Passed 28th March 1851.

Whereas it is deemed expedient to make the Grant allowed by the above mentioned Act to the New Brunswick Society for the encouragement of Agriculture, Home Manufactures and Commerce throughout the Province, to the extent of two hundred pounds, on similar terms as to County Agricultural Societies, and to alter the time for transmitting the proceedings of the said Society to the Provincial Secretary from the first Thursday in January to the second Wednesday in April following;

- I. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the second section of the above mentioned Act be and the same is hereby repealed.
- II. And be it enacted, That whenever the said Society shall make it appear by Certificate under the hand of the Treasurer of such Society, that a sum not less than twenty five pounds has been actually subscribed and paid to the said Treasurer by the Members of such Society, and the President of the said Society shall make application, enclosing the said Certificate to the Lieutenant Governor or Administrator of the Government for the time being, for aid in supporting the said Society, it shall and maybe lawful for the Lieutenant Governor or Administrator of the Government for the time being, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, to issue his Warrant to the Treasurer of the Province in favour of the Treasurer of the said Society, for treble the amount that shall have been so subscribed and paid as aforesaid; provided always, that the annual sum to be granted to the said Society shall not exceed the sum of two hundred pounds currency.
- III. And be it enacted, That the time appointed by the third section of the above mentioned Act for transmitting to the Office of the Provincial Secretary a statement of the proceedings of the said Society, in relation to the expenditure of the moneys therein specified, be and the same is hereby altered from the first Thursday in January to the second Wednesday in April following in each year.
- IV. And be it enacted, That this Act shall continue and be in force until the expiration of the Act to which this is an amendment and no longer.
