15 Victoria – Chapter 10

An Act in further amendment of an Act intituled *An Act for the better extinguishing of Fires which may happen in the City of Saint John*. Passed 18th February 1852.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, as follows:—

- 1. It shall be lawful for the Common Council of the City of Saint John to erect and set up in convenient places, on the east side of the Harbour, such and so many alarm bells, gongs and other suitable instruments for raising alarms of Fire in the City, as they may think expedient, with proper and convenient bellfries, machinery and appurtenances, and for this purpose to use and occupy, if they shall think necessary, any part of King's and Queen's Squares, and by any bye laws, orders or resolutions of Common Council to direct, regulate and provide for the due and proper use, management and employment of the same.
- 2. For the purpose of defraying the expense thereof, the Common Council are authorized, in ordering any assessment during the present year for the support of the Fire Department, to add thereto a sum not exceeding four hundred pounds, to be applied for the purposes of this Act and for no other use or purpose whatsoever, the same to be assessed on the eastern side of the Harbour.
