15 Victoria – Chapter 49

An Act to revive and continue an Act relating to the holding of Circuit Courts and for other purposes. Passed 7th April 1852.

Whereas an Act relating to the holding of Circuit Courts, which expired on the first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty one, was omitted to be continued in the last Session of Assembly: And whereas nonwithstanding the expiration of the said Act, the said Courts have been regularly holden, and the other requirements of the said Act have been duly performed, and it is necessary to legalize the same, and also to revive and continue the said Act; Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, as follows:—

1. Every act, matter and thing done or committed within the meaning and pursuant to the provisions of the Acts of Assembly passed in the ninth year of Her present Majesty's Reign, intituled *An Act relating to Circuit Courts in this Province and to provide for travelling expenses of the Judges holding such Courts*, and every act, matter and thing which may be necessary to complete what may have been begun within the provisions aforesaid, either before or since the expiration of the said Act, are hereby declared to be as valid, legal and effectual as if the said incited Act had been regularly continued.

2. The said recited Act is hereby revived and continued and shall be in force until the first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty five.
