15 Victoria – Chapter 65

An Act to amend an Act intituled *An Act relating to the appointment of Commissioners of Sewers in the Counties of Westmorland and Albert.* Passed 7th April 1852.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, as follows:—

1. From and after the passing of this Act, it shall and may be lawful for the Commissioners of Sewers elected under the provisions of an Act made and passed in the thirteenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act relating to the appointment of Commissioners of Sewers in the Counties of Westmorland and Albert*, to make and repair the roads leading through their respective districts, and to assess the proprietors of the marshes for the expenses thereof, in the manner provided by the fifth section of the said Act.
2. The said Commissioners, before proceeding to make or repair the said roads, or any of them, shall give notice of their intention by advertisement in three or more public places in the district.
3. The proprietors of a majority of the acres in the district in which the roads are to be made or repaired, may, by order in writing, to be personally served on some one or more of the said Commissioners, prohibit the said Commissioners from proceeding with the work so advertised; and on service of the said notice, the Commissioners shall not proceed with the work for one year; and not then until after advertisement as in the first instance, and so on as often as the case shall occur.
