16 Victoria – Chapter 15

An Act to unite a portion of a School District in the Parish of Saint David to the Parish of Saint James, in the County of Charlotte. Passed 14th April 1853.

Whereas the Village of Moore's Mills, in the County of Charlotte, is divided by Dennis River, and lies partly in Saint David and partly in Saint James; and the inhabitants having built a commodious School House and established a School on the Saint James side of the River, are anxious to enjoy the full benefits of the same;'

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, as follows:—

- 1. That the portion of the Parish of Saint David, bounded on the north by the northern line of the land owned by Tristram Moore, east by the eastern line of said land to George S. Smith's southeast corner, thence west along the southern line of said Smith's land, and that of Andrew Bunten, to the Parish line of Saint James, thence along the said Parish line to the first mentioned boundary, be attached to and form part of School District number nine, in the adjoining Parish of Saint James, for all purposes connected with Parish Schools; and that all the inhabitants residing within the before described boundaries be exempted from any action taken or to be taken by the inhabitants of Saint David in regard to Parish Schools, and made subject to the operation of all the laws relating to Parish Schools, so far as such laws apply to the Parish of Saint James, any law or usage to the contrary notwithstanding.
- 2. This Act shall continue in force until the first day of May which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty five.
