16 Victoria – Chapter 22

An Act for altering the time of holding one of the Courts of General Sessions of the Peace and Inferior Court of Common Pleas in the County of Westmorland. Passed 14th April 1853.

Whereas the Terms for holding the Courts of General Sessions of the Peace and Inferior Court of Common Pleas in the County of Westmorland have been found inconvenient; for remedy whereof,

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, as follows:—

- 1. The said Courts shall be hereafter holden on the second Tuesday in December, instead of the third Tuesday in November, in each and every year; provided always, that no Process shall abate or be discontinued by reason of the alteration of the said Term, but shall and may be proceeded upon, heard and determined at the Term herein appointed, in the same manner as they might have been proceeded upon had no alteration been made.
- 2. An Act made and passed in the fourth year of the Reign of His Majesty King George the Fourth, intituled An Act for altering the Terms of holding the Court of General Sessions of the Peace and Inferior Court of Common Pleas in the County of Westmorland; also so much of an Act made and passed in the thirteenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled An Act to consolidate and amend the Laws to provide for the administration of Justice in the Inferior Courts of Common Pleas and General Sessions of the Peace, as provides for the holding of the Inferior Court of Common Pleas and General Sessions of the Peace in and for the said County of Westmorland on the third Tuesday in November, be and the same are hereby repealed.
