16 Victoria – Chapter 31

An Act in amendment of the Law relating to Inland Posts. Passed 3rd May 1853.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, as follows:—

1. The third section of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act in addition to the Law relating to Inland Posts*, respecting the transmission of printed Books and other publications between the United Kingdom and this Province, together with the Schedule therein referred to, is hereby repealed.
2. It shall be lawful for His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor in Council, by Order in Council duly made and published in the Royal Gazette, to carry out any arrangements from time to time made for facilitating the transmission of Books and Pamphlets, or for reducing the rate of Postage on Letters between Great Britain and the Colonies, which may be sanctioned by Her Majesty's Postmaster General, or by the Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, and may regulate the transmission by Post from one part of the Colony to the other, of all such Books or Pamphlets, on such terms and in such manner as to His Excellency in Council shall seem meet; and every such Order in Council shall, when published by authority in the Royal Gazette, have the same force and effect as if in this Act contained.
