16 Victoria – Chapter 50

**An Act relating to the Saint Andrews and Quebec Rail Road Company. Passed 3rd May 1853.**

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, as follows:—

1. So much of the fourth section of the Act made and passed in the fourteenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act to facilitate the construction of a Railway from Saint Andrews to Quebec*, as authorises the Legislative Council and Assembly, by joint resolution, to appoint two Directors, who shall have the same power and authority as any other Directors chosen under the Act of incorporation; together with the Act made and passed during the present Session, intituled *An Act to amend the Act to facilitate the construction of a Railway from Saint Andrews to Quebec*, be and the same are hereby repealed.
2. The Lieutenant Governor or Administrator of the Government for the time being, in Council may, and he is hereby required annually, or from time to time, as occasion shall require, to appoint two Directors in the Saint Andrews and Quebec Rail Road Company, who shall have the same power and authority as any other Directors chosen by the said Company under their Acts of incorporation; and in case of such Directors, or either of them, refusing or neglecting to act, or for other good cause, to cancel such appointment, and another or others to appoint in his or their stead.
