18 Victoria – Chapter 2

An Act to relieve certain Articles from the payment of Duty. Passed 3rd November 1854.

Section.

1. Free importation of certain articles allowed.

Whereas it is desirable to relieve certain Articles hereafter imported into this Province from the payment and collection of any duty or duties imposed by any Act or Acts now in force;

1. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, That from and after the passing of this Act, the Articles hereinafter enumerated, shall and may be imported free from all duty, for and notwithstanding any Act or Law now in force to the contrary, that is to say:—Molasses, Grain, Flour, Meal, and Salted and Cured Meats of all kinds.
