18 Victoria – Chapter 29

An Act to amend the Law relating to Sick and Disabled Seamen. Passed 12th April 1855.

Duty increased on Vessels arriving at the Ports of Richibucto and Buctouche.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—That the master, owner, or consignee of every vessel being of the burthen of sixty tons or upwards, that shall arrive at the Ports of Richibucto and Buctouche [Bouctouche], shall pay to the Deputy Treasurer at such Ports the sum of two pence per ton for every ton at which such vessel may be rated in the register thereof, in lieu of one penny per ton as provided to be paid at those Ports by the third Section of Chapter 22, of Title III, of the Revised Statutes, "Of Sick and Disabled Seamen."
