18 Victoria – Chapter 50

An Act to alter the division line between the Parishes of Chipman and Waterborongh, in Queen's County. Passed 12th April 1855.

Division line altered.

Whereas the division line between the Parishes of Chipman and Waterborough as now established is found to be attended with inconvenience, and an alteration is desirable;— Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,— That all that part of the present Parish of Chipman which lies on the southeastern side of Coal Creek, so called, be deemed and declared to be included in the said Parish of Waterborough, and to form a part thereof, any law to the contrary thereof notwithstanding.
