

Acts of the General Assembly of Her Majesty's Province of New-Brunswick passed in the year 1855. Fredericton, NB: John Simpson, Printer to the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, 1855.

18 Victoria – Chapter 55

An Act authorizing the sale, by the Bishop of Fredericton, of certain lands in Harvey, in the County of Albert, for the purposes of the Church in that Parish.

Section.

1. Authority given to sell Church land at Harvey corner.

Section.

2. The Bishop's deed to be a good title.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, as follows:—

1. The Lord Bishop of Fredericton is hereby authorized and empowered to sell and convey such portion of this lot of land at Harvey corner, in Harvey, County of Albert, upon which the Episcopal Church is now erected, as is not required for the said Church; the proceeds of said sale or conveyance to be appropriated towards the liquidation of any debts incurred in the erection of said Church.

2. The deed or conveyance given by the said Lord Bishop under the provisions of this Act, shall have the effect to convey a good and sufficient title to the purchaser or purchasers, his or their heirs and assigns.
