18 Victoria – Chapter 56

An Act to authorize the sale of Glebe lands in the Parish of Moncton. Passed 12th April 1855.

Sale of part of Glebe of Saint George's Church, Moncton, and reinvestment, authorized.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,— That the Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry of Saint George's Church, in the Parish of Moncton, in the County of Westmorland, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to sell and dispose of all or any part of the Glebe Lands in the said Parish, for such price or prices as they may be able to obtain therefor, and thereupon to make and execute good, legal, and sufficient conveyances of the same in fee, and to invest the proceeds thereof in other lands, or in the erection of a Parsonage for the use of the Rector of the said Church, and his successors; such conveyance to be valid only upon being signed by the Lord Bishop of Fredericton, or his consent endorsed thereon.
