An Act to authorize the Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry of Saint David's Church, in the Parish of Saint David, in the County of Charlotte, to sell and dispose of certain lands in the said Parish, and invest the proceeds in other lands. Passed 12th April 1855.

Whereas it is deemed advisable to sell certain lands in the Parish of Saint David, granted to the Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry of Saint David's Church, in the said Parish, and invest the proceeds arising from such sale in the purchase of other lands more convenient and beneficial for a Glebe for the use of the Rector;—

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, as follows:—

1. That the Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry of Saint David's Church, in the Parish of Saint David, in the County of Charlotte, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, by and with the sanction and consent of the Lord Bishop of the Diocese, to sell, dispose of, and convey all and singular the said lands, and execute good and sufficient deeds of the same in fee simple to the purchasers.

2. The amount arising from such sale shall be invested by the said Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry, in the purchase of other freehold lands, more conveniently situated for the use and benefit of the Rector or Minister of the said Church for the time being as a Glebe.
