18 Victoria – Chapter 64

An Act in amendment of an Act to enable the Dorchester Manufacturing Company of the City of New York to hold property in this Province. Passed 12th April 1855.

Section.

1. Company empowered to hold real estate to the value of £10,000.

Section.

2. When Act to come into operation.

Whereas by an Act passed in the present Session of the General Assembly, the Dorchester Manufacturing Company of the City of New York are authorized to hold real estate in this Province to the value of two thousand five hundred pounds, and such personal estate as they may desire, the same not being limited to any amount; and it is necessary that they should be authorized to hold real estate to a larger amount than they are thereby authorized;—

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, as follows:—

1. The said Company and their successors shall have full power and lawful right and authority, and they are hereby authorized and empowered to have, hold, own, and enjoy in any way real estate and lands of all kinds in this Province, whether in fee simple, or by lease, or in any other way, to the value of ten thousand pounds, and to alienate, encumber, lease, sell, or deal with the same in any manner, in addition to the power and authority to hold personal estate thereby granted, any thing therein contained to the contrary notwithstanding.
2. This Act shall come into operation on the day when the said recited Act comes into operation.
