## An Act to amend the Act relating to the repairing of Bye Roads and Bridges in this Province. Passed 26th March 1856.

Time for transmitting lists of elected Officers altered as to Charlotte County.

Whereas the election of Town and Parish Officers for the several Parishes in the County of Charlotte takes place at too late a period to enable the Clerk of the Peace to make the return required by the said Act in proper time, and the Commissioners must necessarily be appealed instead of being elected to expend the Bye Road money, as contemplated by the said Act;— Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—That the time for the Clerk of the Peace of the County of Charlotte to make and transmit the list required by the third Section of the Act passed in the eighteenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled "An Act relating to the repairing of Bye Roads and Bridges in this Province," shall be on or before the second Tuesday IN April in each and every year, instead of the first day of April, as in the said Section mentioned.
