20 Victoria – Chapter 30 Session 2

An Act to incorporate the First Universalist Society at Milltown in the Parish of Saint Stephen. Passed 26th March 1857.

Section. Section.

1. First Universalist Society in Milltown incorporated.

2. Annual rent of land limited.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, as follows:—

- 1. That Joel Hill, Abner Hill, Daniel Hill, Horatio N. Hill, Robert M. Todd, Freeman H. Todd, Seth M. Todd, Abner M'Alister, James S. Hall, and such other male persons as are or may become members of the Society hereinafter named, be and they are hereby created and declared to be a body politic and corporate in deed and in name, and shall have succession for ever, by the name of First Universalist Society in Saint Stephen, and by that name shall be enabled to sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto, defend and be defended in any Court or Courts of law or equity, or any other place whatsoever, and shall have full power and capacity to purchase, convey, receive, take, hold and enjoy, for the use and benefit of the said Society, as well goods and chattels as lands, tenements and hereditaments, and improve and use the same for the benefit of the said Society, and shall have all the other general powers and privileges not hereinbefore mentioned and contained, made incident to a Corporation by any Act of Assembly of this Province.
- 2. Provided always, that the amount of annual rents, profits and receipts of such lands, tenements, goods, chattels and hereditaments, shall not exceed the sum of one thousand pounds.
