An Act to amend the first Section of Chapter 19, Title III, of the Revised Statutes, "Of Buoys and Beacons." Passed 1st July 1857.

Tonnage money increased as to Porta in Restigouche.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—That the Master, Owner or Consignee of every Vessel that may arrive at any Port in the Bay or Harbour of Restigouche, shall pay to the Deputy Treasurers at said Ports respectively the sum of one penny per ton at which such Vessel may be rated in the Register thereof, in lieu of one half-penny as provided to be paid at the said Ports by the first Section of Chapter 19, Title III, of the Revised Statutes, "Of Buoys and Beacons."
