21 Victoria – Chapter 13

An Act to compel Vessels navigating the Bay of Fundy to carry Lights. Passed 6th April 1858.

Signal Lights to be shown.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—That all Vessels navigating the Bay of Fundy and the inlets thereof, shall and are hereby required, while so sailing, plying, floating, or lying at anchor during the night season—that is between sun-set and sun-rise—to keep a good signal light at the foremast head in fore and aft vessels, and at the bowsprit end in square rigged vessels, under the penalty of five pounds for each and every neglect, to be paid by the master, owner or person in charge of such vessel, to be recovered and applied as penalties imposed by an Act passed in the seventeenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act relating to Steam Navigation in this Province*.
