## An Act appointing a Polling place in Queen's County. Passed 6th April 1858.

Polling place for Parish of Cambridge.

Whereas a place for taking the Poll at contested elections to be held for Members to serve in the General Assembly in this Province, for the Parish of Cambridge, in Queen's County, has not been provided;—

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—That for the Parish of Cambridge, in Queen's County, "At or near Gilbert Dykeman's," in the said Parish, shall be and is hereby declared to be the place for taking the poll at alt contested elections hereafter to be held for Members to serve in the General Assembly in this Province.
