An Act to amend an Act intituled An Act to authorize and empower the Church Wardens and Vestry of Trinity Church, in Springfield, in King's County, to sell certain Glebe Lands in said Parish, and vest the proceeds in other Lands. Passed 6th April 1858.

Section. 3. Lands to be held for a glebe.

Proceeds of sale to be invested.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, as follows:-

1. That the second Section of an Act made and passed in the eighteenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act to authorize and empower the Church Wardens and Vestry of Trinity Church, in Springfield, in King's County, to sell certain Glebe Lands in said Parish, and vest the proceeds in other Lands,* be and the same is hereby repealed; and in lieu thereof,—

2. The amount arising from the sale authorized by the first Section of the said recited Act shall be invested by the said Rector, Church Wardens and Vestry, in other good securities, until an eligible opportunity for purchasing a suitable lot of land may occur.

3. The said lot of land, when purchased, shall be held by the said Rector, Church Wardens and Vestry for a Glebe for the use of the Rector of said Church for the time being.
