21 Victoria – Chapter 64

An Act to incorporate the Saint Andrews Mechanics' Institute. Passed 6th April 1858.

Company incorporated with general powers of Corporations.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—That George D. Street, Thomas Berry, Walter M. Buck, Benjamin R. Stevenson, Thomas Turner, Nathan N. Treadwell, John Watson, Donald Clark, Charles Stevenson, and such other persons as are or may become Members of an Institution founded in Saint Andrews, in the County of Charlotte, for the intellectual advancement of Mechanics and others, and the consequent improvement of society at large, by establishing a Library and such other sources of information as will be instrumental in promoting the circulation of popular and useful science, and a knowledge of its application to the arts and manufactures, shall be and they are hereby constituted a body corporate for the above purposes, and no others, by the name of "The Saint Andrews Mechanics' Institute," with all the general powers and privileges incident to Corporations by Act of Assembly in this Province; provided always, that the real estate which the said Corporation may at any time bold shall not exceed eight hundred pounds.
