21 Victoria – Chapter 66

An Act to incorporate the Milltown Lower Dam Company in the Parish of Saint Stephen. Passed 6th April 1858.

Company incorporated with general powers of Corporations.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—That the owners of property deriving any benefit for the purpose of driving Machinery of any kind by the water restrained or secured by the Milltown Lower Dam in the Parish of Saint Stephen, be incorporated, and Henry F. Eaton, John M'Adam, James P. Brown, P. M. Pirington, C. W. Strout, S. Clarke Levett, and William E. M'Allister, and such other person or persons as now are or may hereafter become owner or owners of any such above mentioned interest in the said water so restrained as aforesaid by the said Lower Darn, shall be and they are hereby constituted a body corporate for the purpose aforesaid, by the name of "The Milltown Lower Dam Company," with all the general powers and privileges made incident to a Corporation by Act of Assembly in this Province; provided always, that the real estate which said Corporation may at any time hold shall not exceed five hundred pounds.
