22 Victoria – Chapter 16

**An Act to repeal an Act intituled *An Act to amend the Law for the relief of Insolvent Debtors.*  
Passed 13th April 1859.**

2. Rights of Mortgagees, protected.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—

1. That an Act made and passed in the twenty first year of the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled *An Act to amend the Law for the relief of Insolvent Debtors*, be and the same is hereby repealed: Provided always, that ail proceedings already commenced under the provisions of the said Act, shall be prosecuted and finally determined in all respects as if this Act had not been passed; and all proceedings had, acts done, and orders for discharge granted, or that may be had, done, or granted under the said Act, shall be as effectual to all intents and purposes as if the said Act had not been repealed.

2. It is hereby declared, that nothing in the Act hereby repealed, or any order of discharge given or that may be given thereunder, shall in any way or manner affect or impair, or be construed to affect or in any way or manner impair, the rights, legal or equitable, of any bona fide mortgagee.
