22 Victoria – Chapter 26

An Act to alter the time for holding the Inferior Courts of Common Pleas and General Sessions of the Peace in the Counties of York and Sunbury. Passed 13th April 1859.

Section.

1. Time for Courts of Common Pleas for York and Sunbury.

Section.

2. Act 13 V. c. 47, in part repealed.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, as follows:—

1. That the Term of the Inferior Courts of Common Pleas for the Counties of York and Sunbury, and the Courts of General Sessions of the Peace for the said Counties, shall hereafter be held on the first Tuesday in January in each and every year instead of the second Tuesday in January, provided that when the first Tuesday in January shall happen to be New Year's Day, the said Courts shall open on the following day, but all the proceedings shall be as of the first Tuesday, and relate thereto.

2. That so much of an Act made and passed in the thirteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled An Act to consolidate and amend the Lam to provide for the administration of Justice in the Inferior Courts of Common Pleas and General Sessions of the Peace, as is inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, is hereby repealed.
