22 Victoria – Chapter 27

An Act in amendment of Chapter 137, Title XXXVII, of the Revised Statutes, 'Of the jurisdiction of Justices in Civil Suits,' so far as relates to the duties of Constables. Passed 13th April 1859.

Process any be served by Parish Constables in any part of the County.

Whereas doubts at present exist whether processes can be legally served by Constables appointed for a particular Parish, beyond the limits of the Parish for which such Constable may have been elected or appointed;—

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, — That all processes is actions before Justices of the Peace in Civil Suits, may be served by Constables appointed or elected for any particular Parish, in any part of the respective Counties in which the Parish for which the said Constable may have been elected or appointed is situated.
